Thinking about an article for this month it is natural to look forward to Father's Day.

Interestingly, God is an on time God for today's devotional came from John 16:23, and as is my practice, I read the whole chapter. You see, I like to hear all of the story- or at least a couple of verses before and a couple after. Jesus is telling the disciples that he is going to go away for a little while but he will be back with them and then he will not speak in parables. And they began to question what he meant by "in a little while, He would be back". **26** In that day you will ask in my name. I am not saying that I will ask the Father on your behalf. **27** No, the Father himself loves you because you have loved me and have believed that I came from God. **28** I came from the Father and entered the world; now I am leaving the world and going back to the Father." John 16: 26-28

We all know the story so I don't need to explain what Jesus meant by this expression. However, I found what he says later to be very interesting...



What caught my attention was "the himself Father loves you because you have loved me and have believed that I came from God"
