February is the month of love.

Some look forward to our secular celebration of the greatest trait the human genome carries – the ability to love others, pets, and the universe. Did you notice that in speaking of Valentines Day I left out the most important aspect of love - the love of God. All of the people of the Jewish faith know what is called "the Shema". The Shema stands at the center of daily morning and evening prayer services. It is considered by some the most essential prayer in all of Judaism. The Shema affirms God's infinity and kingship, its daily recitation is regarded by observant Jews as a commandment. We all know this as Jesus' golden rule...but for the Jews the Shema is found in Deuteronomy 6:4-9

Hear, O Israel: The Lord is our God, the Lord alone. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might. Keep these words that I am commanding you today in your heart. Recite them to your children and talk about them when you are at home and when you are away, when you lie down and when you rise. Bind them as a sign on your hand, fix them as an emblem on your forehead, and write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

Obviously, this prayer is very important for the people of God. I sense that the reason this "love of God" is so important stems from the truth- all true love begins with God. So important that God commanded His people to love Him and to teach the children to love God with all our heart, soul and with all our might. What we often miss as Protestants is the importance of the spoken word. You see God taught His people to pray this outloud daily! Why? Because God is a god who proclaims to all the world who He is and how great is His love. He is also a God of commitment - He writes a contract with Abraham declaring He has promised to bless Abraham and his descendants. When the Jews proclaim this in their prayers each day they are declaring submission to the King of kings and the Lord of lords. A declaration and promise that goes before the court of heaven! Can you see why God is determined to rescue the Israelite nation? Why God again and again forgives them? Just as He again and again forgives us. And why again and again He shares in His word to forgive and love one another by this the world will know we are Christians by our love.

Can you see the progression of loving God with all our heart, soul and strength brings about the greatest love from us and extends to others? For if Christ can love us in our sin so much so -that He gives up His life for us -then in response we can give up our life for Him. That is real love. The kind of love that God is looking for that conquers all evil. Let us declare our love of God out loud as often as we can! Happy Valentine's Day to you all! Love the Lord your God with all your heart, and all your soul and all your strength and love you neighbor (even if they are your enemy) as yourself.
