#### **HOLY WEEK**

Holy Week was filled with opportunities for worship as we reflected and honored Jesus Christ for His work at the cross! Beginning with services that started on Palm Sunday, a traditional Maundy Thursday service was held, along with

Stations of the Cross, a drop-in event held all day Friday.

The Holy Thursday service, held in the Jack Overcash Fellowship Hall incorporated readings and elements of the Seder Meal that Jesus and His disciples would have partaken the night of Passover. Many who attended shared how meaningful the service was on the eve of the Crucifixion. Many thanks to our worship leader, Lisa Zeggert for the incorporation of the Seder Meal elements.

On Fri. April 18, Pastor Melanie, Lisa Zeggert & Stacey Robinette setup the Stations of the Cross. At 14 stations, the participant was set on a journey that began at the Garden of Gethsemane and traveled through to the Crucifixion. Each station had scripture and a summary of what was happening at the time. This was a solemn occasion, and 39 adults and children took the opportunity to go through.

On Sun. April 20, more than 100 individuals joined in celebration of Jesus' Resurrection during both the 8:00AM & 10:00AM services. Special Easter music was enjoyed, that included Resurrection Medley by our Vanderburg Church Choir. Following the service, many took the opportunity to get family pictures at the beautiful cross adorned with fresh flowers in celebration of Jesus' Resurrection!


