## 1 Supporting FeedNC

At FeedNC, everyone is welcome to enjoy lunch at Donoghue's Open Door. From 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. M-F, all are welcome to choose from their menu offerings and enjoy meals at community tables. There is no charge for the food, but donations are accepted. Last year alone, 50K meals were served.

## 2 Our Daily Bread

Did you know that because of your giving, we are able to support Our Daily Bread each quarter.

More than just the daily devotion, a recent letter highlighted the work they do in prison ministry. Last year, to help alleviate loneliness, Our Daily Bread sent 65,000 Christmas Hope Packets that included a Christmas Card, an Armor Book and snacks.

## 3 Supporting Samaritan's Purse

Recently, Samaritan's Purse shared that the organization will continue to send much-needed food and medical help to the Gaza region. Since July, 2025, they've sent 12 relief flights to the middle east with over 200 tons of ready-to-use supplemental nutrition pouches.

## 4 Supporting Christian Mission

Christian Mission recently shared that in 2024, they served over 6600 individuals, a 43% increase over the year before. They are grateful for the support of the community as they continue to help families move toward stability and self-sufficiency.




